

DETAILED CONTEST RULES FOR 8" DICE ROLL - RADIO: Summer Cash Give a Way

1. How to Enter the Contest:

- a. The "Summer Cash Give-a-way" contest will begin June 14, 2019 and end on August 3, 2019 at Mill Bay Casino.
- b. To participate in the contest, register for a chance to win at our various locations throughout the summer during our live Summer Broadcasts. To register, arrive at our live broadcast and fill out an entry form. We will choose 6 lucky listeners at each remote for their chance to win the \$25,000. The final remote on August 3rd will give listeners the chance at any remaining rolls left out of our 100 rolls. A minimum of 10 rolls will be available during our final broadcast.
- c. Limit one (1) entry per person. Entrants may be disqualified at the sole discretion of Icicle Broadcasting.

2. Eligibility Restrictions:

- a. The contest is open to all contest participants who are 18 years of age or older and who reside in Washington State. Employees, officers, and directors of Client, Sponsors and Odds On Promotions, their respective affiliated companies, subsidiaries, distributors, dealers, retailers, printers, advertising, and promotion agencies, any and all other companies associated with this contest, and the members of the immediate families or households of any of the above are not eligible. Immediate family shall include spouse, parents, children, siblings, grandparents, grandchildren and any other person residing within the same household.
- b. Only one (1) winner per household is permitted in any contest.

3. Prizes:

- a. Grand Prize: USD: \$25,000. A maximum of ONE Grand Prize(s) will be awarded. If the ONE available Grand Prize is won in accordance with these Rules, the contest will officially end at the time the Grand Prize is won. If no contestant successfully rolls the 5 dice with "WIN" face up in accordance with these rules, no Grand Prize will be awarded.
- b. Grand Prize is provided courtesy of Odds On Promotions.
- c. All prizes or prize certificates may be picked up at the office of Icicle Broadcasting at 32 N Mission Street, Wenatchee WA or in Chelan at 123 E. Johnson. Any prize or prize certificate not claimed within forty five days of winning will be forfeited by the winner. In the event that a prize or prize certificate is mailed to the winner, it will be with the prior written consent of the winner and therefore, winner assumes the risk of its arrival. Icicle Broadcasting is not responsible for the safe arrival of a prize or prize certificate.
- d. Contest prizes are not transferable. Prizes may not be substituted for or redeemed for cash.
- e. Grand Prize winner will receive 1099 IRS Tax form for the value of the Grand Prize as stated in these contest rules.
- f. Prizes are limited solely to those items explicitly set forth herein and shall not include any and all other expenses, incidentals or taxes that may arise out of the winner's receipt of this prize.

4. Selection and Notification of Winners:

- a. Decisions of Icicle Broadcasting management with respect to the contest are final.
- b. A total of 100 finalist(s) will be randomly selected from all eligible entries received to participate in the contest. A selected finalist that cannot be reached or contacted to confirm their selection, does not meet the eligibility requirements, or does not wish to participate in the Grand Prize contest will be disqualified. An alternate finalist will be randomly selected.
- c. The first 100 eligible contestants will be given the opportunity to attempt to win a Grand Prize by providing all requested information in the official registration binder and rolling a set of 5 pre-printed dice after receiving instructions to do so from the Contest Administrator. In order to be a valid attempt, each eligible contestant must:
 - i. Print and sign their full name in the official registration binder on the next unoccupied line. Name must be printed clearly to be eligible.
 - ii. After completing this information, and upon direction of the Icicle Broadcasting, the contestant must then roll the provided set of (5) dice in accordance with the requirements outlined herein.
 - iii. Limit one (1) entry per person.
- d. In order for a Grand Prize to be awarded, the (5) dice rolled by the contestant must come to rest a minimum of three (3) feet with "WIN" face up in accordance with these rules, and the contestant must be the first contestant to have achieved this result.
- e. All dice roll attempts must occur in the presence of the contest administrator, and must be recorded on video tape in their entirety. Any dice roll attempt not in the presence of the contest Administrator, or that is not videotaped in its entirety for any reason will be disqualified and is not eligible for a Grand Prize, regardless of the outcome.
- f. Contestants are not permitted to take any practice or warm-up rolls prior to their attempt. Once any one die has been rolled, their attempt is considered to be started.
- g. Each eligible contestant must roll/throw each oversized die one (1) at a time. Contestants may not attempt to change the outcome of any rolled die by hitting the die with a subsequent roll attempt.
- h. Each die must be tossed in a way that does not allow the contestant to "set" the dice, alter or influence the random outcome of the roll.
- i. Each die must be rolled a minimum of six (6) feet in distance from the contestant, in order to prevent the contestant from altering, affecting, influencing, or enhancing the random outcome of any roll. The contest Administrator will designate the demarcation line that each die must cross during the roll attempt, as well as the line behind which the contestant must be positioned to take his/her attempt.
- j. Each dice must make a minimum of two (2) complete rotations while in the air.
- k. All dice must come to rest lying individually and completely flat.
- l. All dice must land on and remain on the designated dice rolling surface.
- m. No rolled die may come in contact with any person or object other than the designated rolling surfaces or walls.
- n. If any die comes in contact with another person or object (other than the dice roll surface or designated walls or backstop, or other dice) for any reason; or if any person or object in any way

interferes, alters, changes, influences or affects the random outcome of the roll, then the entire attempt is disqualified and the contestant may not receive another attempt for the duration of the contest period.

- o. The following will result in the contestant being required to re-roll their entire dice roll attempt:
 - i. If any of the following outcomes occur, that dice roll attempt is disqualified and the contestant will be granted a maximum of one re-roll attempt (the contestant must re-roll that die only):
 - 1. If the contest administrator deems that any die has failed to cross the dice roll demarcation line.
 - 2. If any die is leaning in any manner.
 - 3. If any die leaves the designated dice roll playing surface.
 - 4. If any contestant inadvertently drops a die as they are preparing to roll, and the dropped die does not meet the eligible dice roll requirements as stated in the contest rules.
 - 5. In all circumstances, an eligible contestant may have a maximum of one re-roll attempt. In the event of a second ineligible dice roll, their entire dice roll attempt will be disqualified and the contestant will not be eligible for any prize claim regardless of the outcome of their roll.
 - p. The odds of being selected as an official contestant(s) are dependent upon the number of entries received. The odds of winning the contest once selected as an official contestant are: 1:100.

5. Conditions:

- a. Payment of all federal, state and local taxes are the sole responsibility of the winner. Winners will be required to sign an IRS Form W-9 or the equivalent. Failure or refusal to execute the release will result in winner forfeiting the prize. Photo identification and social security number of the Grand Prize winner may also be required in order to collect the prize.
- b. By participating in the contest, the winner or winners (and their guest or traveling companion, if any) agree to have their name, voice, or likeness used in any advertising or broadcasting material relating to this contest without additional financial or other compensation, and to sign a publicity release prior to acceptance of the prize.
- c. A maximum (1) Grand Prize(s) will be awarded. Grand Prize winner must accept delivery of prize from Icicle Broadcasting, or as otherwise instructed by sponsor. All other costs related to prize delivery and acceptance are the responsibility of winner including but not limited to all federal state and local taxes. All properly claimed prizes will be awarded. Prizes are non-transferable and no cash redemption or prize substitution allowed, except at Icicle Broadcastings sole discretion or as provided herein. Icicle Broadcasting reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value if an advertised prize becomes unavailable.
- d. Grand Prize winner(s) will be required to complete and return a W-9 form (*if prize value exceeds \$600.00*), affidavit of eligibility, and liability/publicity release (*Tennessee residents need not sign publicity release*), and present a valid driver's license and social security card before prize will be awarded. Winners of prizes greater than \$600.00 will be issued a 1099 form reflecting the value of the prize(s) and are responsible for paying all income taxes on prize(s). Pursuant to the liability release, the winners will agree to hold Odds On Promotions, Icicle Broadcasting, its licensee, their affiliated companies and the officers, shareholders, directors, employees, agents and representatives of each of them harmless against any and all claims or liability arising directly or indirectly from the prize or participation in the contest.

- e. Icicle Broadcasting reserves the right in its sole discretion to modify the contest rules and dates at any time for any reason. Material modifications shall be announced on-air, when practical. By participating in this contest, you agree to be bound by these contest rules, any modifications thereof, and by all other rules imposed by the Icicle Broadcasting.
- f. No purchase is necessary. Purchase does not increase chances of winning. The contest is void where prohibited.
- g. Failure to comply with the contest rules may result in a contestant's disqualification, at the sole discretion of the Icicle Broadcasting.
- h. Icicle Broadcasting is not responsible for typographical or other errors in the printing, the offering or the administration of the contest or in the announcement of a prize.
